Attenborough Nature Reserve

A Vork Pie walk

A lot of different routes are possible, described here are two of my favourites exploring this idyllic nature reserve.

Short route (Blue)

From the car park roundabout with Attenborough Nature Centre on your right, follow the tarmacked path over a bridge. Turn left through a gate at Wheatear Field, which usually has two friendly horses in it. This takes you along the less trodden Wet Marsh Path, a green tunnel that often opens up to give glimpses at the large ponds to on either side. It can get a bit muddy though. Can you find the old bridge in the undergrowth? The path soon rejoins the tarmacked Main Path, always keeping left here* circles around Tween Pond to lead you back to the car park.

Longer route (Purple)

*Alternatively, turn right when you meet the main path and immediately left to follow the river Trent downstream. Turn left just after a weir; always keeping right leads you to circle the green thicket of The Delta Sanctuary until re-joining the river Trent. Retrace your steps upstream completing the round back to the start of the longer route. Turn right and keeping left, follow the path around Tween pond to lead you back to the carpark.
